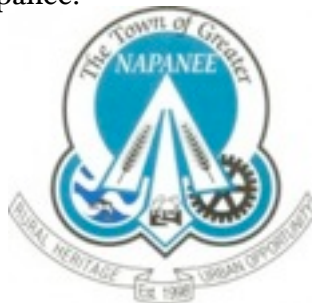
You do not need to be a curler to volunteer.
